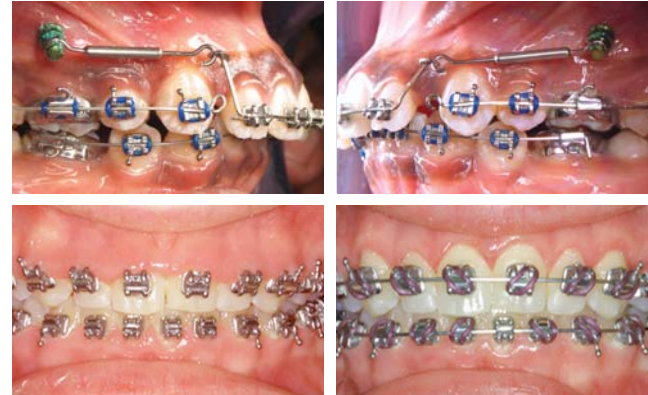

Fisher has placed in excess of one thousand Temporary Orthodontic Anchorage Devices. 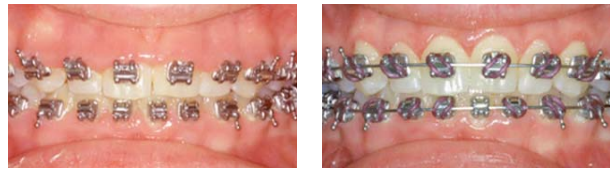
